Our Kindness Connections program adds enrichment opportunities in sports, art, music, dance, family events, and support groups. And with our new Kindness Express mobile boutique, we're hitting the road to bring these resources directly to the communities that need them most.

#### The Details

Time Commitment: Full-time (40 hours/week), with weekends required and occasional evening meetings.

**PLOCATION:** Primarily at The Kindness Exchange (Emmaus, PA), with some remote work and occasional off-site events.
